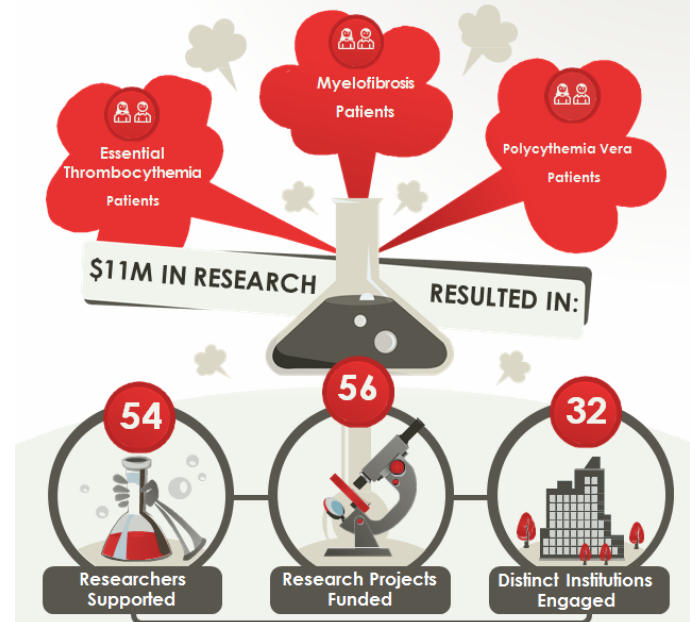

MPNRF Grant Process

Goal: To stimulate MPN research, open new areas of study, and accelerate development of treatments; we do not fund areas that are already well-funded; we seek unmet need.

- We have changed process to meet the needs of changing MPN scientific environment
 - Small studies in diverse areas (2000-2005)
 - Major focus on JAK2 preclinical testing (2005-2008)
 - New & established investigator grants, including focus on MPN genomics (2009-2011)
 - MF/MPN Challenge, with specific focus on myelofibrosis (2012-2016)
- Process has evolved (and become more rigorous) over time
 - We use a broad panel of MPN and interdisciplinary experts for review of proposals
 - We use the MPN Roundtable to help set direction for future grant programs

The MPN Roundtable

First held in November, 2013 with single goal: to bring academic and industry experts together to exchange ideas and identify unmet need in MPN research

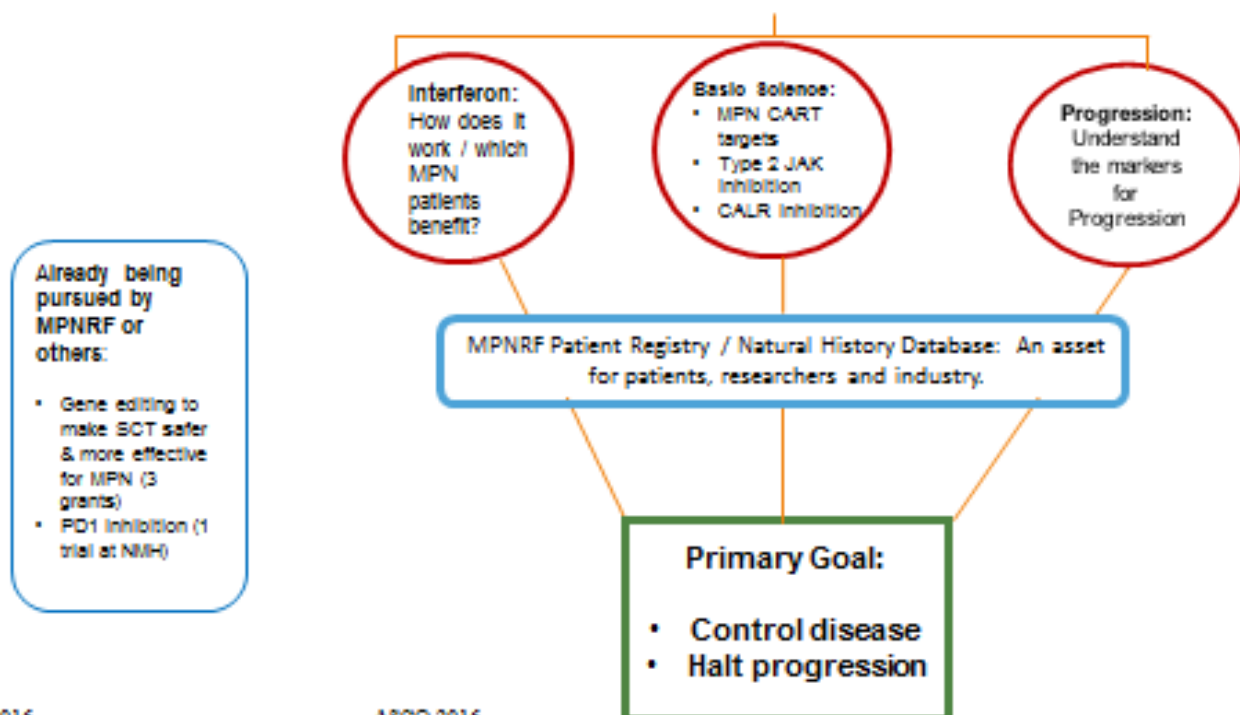
One day, fly-in/fly-out meeting at O'Hare Hilton in Chicago; participants include keynote speakers (on relevant MPN topics), MPNRF grantees, and industry scientists drawn from Industry Advisory Board

From first Roundtable, very positive review from both academic and industry participants. Collaborations/partnerships started. Participation lively. MPNRF grant program benefits by being directed to unmet research needs.
