

Professor Dr. med. Steffen Koschmieder is board-certified in Internal Medicine, Hematology/Oncology, and Hemostaseology. He studied Medicine in Bochum and Mainz, Dijon, Houston, and Salt Lake City, received his specialty training in Frankfurt and Münster, and was a postdoctoral researcher in Prof. Daniel Tenen's laboratory at the Harvard Institutes of Medicine in Boston. He is professor for "Translational Hematology and Oncology" at RWTH Aachen University as well as Attending Physician, Head of Research, Head of Clinical Hemostasis, and Co-Head of the Clinical Laboratory of Molecular Hematology in the Department of Hematology, Oncology, Hemostaseology and Stem Cell Transplantation in Aachen. Prof. Koschmieder's main interests are Myeloproliferative Neoplasms (MPN) and disorders of hemostasis and blood coagulation. He performs clinical trials and preclinical research in the lab and is the Research Coordinator of the Clinical Research Unit (CRU344) focusing on MPN and myelofibrosis, which is funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG). He is one of the speakers of the German Study Group for MPN (GSG-MPN) and co-lead of the GSG-MPN bioregistry.
